NAIL YOUR MANUAL FOCUS - Why You Shouldn't Autofocus

One trick is to focus your camera at a distant (infinity) object during the day using your trusty autofocus. Then, switch the camera to manual focus and use a piece of gaffer tape to keep the focus on the lens from moving. This technique could also work for objects that are closer than the infinity distance, but only the most dedicated photographers focus on something close-up during the day and then wait for darkness without moving their rig!
